PhD process

Hungarian doctoral program is divided into two phases:

•First phase: lasts for 2 years (semester 1-4) This is designed to provide detailed academic subject knowledge as a foundation for your independent research.

•Second phase: lasts for 2 years (semester 5-8), during which you will be recognized as a full **doctoral candidate**, researching an original project.

We usually allow an optional additional year to finalize the thesis. An application is required.



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The doctoral studies last for **8 semesters**. Total **minimum required** number of credits: **240 credits**

- Courses (Learning activity)
- Reports (Semester research and study reports)
- Publications (Publication activity)
- Research projects (Project contribution)
- Teaching activity

First phase (semester 1-4)

Min. 8 courses/first 4 semesters – 6 credits/course



- 2 courses: related to the research topic

4 elective courses chosen by the candidate in agreement with the supervisor(s)

Semester research and study reports

• At the end of each semester

Written report (in agreement with the supervisor(s)) + oral exam



in written form and oral presentation

Reports

At the end of every semester:

- 1-4: 8 credits/sem. $\Sigma = 32$
- 5-8: 15 credits/sem. $\Sigma = 60$
 - Σ = 92 credits



Activity in Research projects (with your supervisor)

6-10 credits/project



Complex exam

Conditions:

After the 4. semester

minimum 90 credits

Σ = 48+32+...=80+... = 90

Complex exam

At the end of the First phase

 An oral exam, designed to test your general subject knowledge, your awareness of methodological principles and your familiarity with topic of your research. It won't relate directly to the contents of your intended research project.



Complex Exam

Two parts

1. Theoretical part: Exam in 3 courses

2. Current state of the research a plan for the near future

Process of PhD thesis defense

 Submission of the 1st version of the thesis for evaluation

- Two positive reviews (one reviewer outside the Óbuda University) and
- Passed PhD exam

Final exam

Submission of the final version of the PhD thesis

- Two positive opinions of reviewers on corrected PhD
- Passed final exam (public defense)

Members of university's doctoral council: award the PhD degree

Public defense of thesis

- Hungarian PhD grades
- *Rite* ('pass') confirming that the requirements against PhD degree has been passed
- Cum laude ('with honours') affirming that your work has exceeded the minimum standard for a doctorate
- Summa cum laude ('with highest honours') – affirming that your work was of exceptional quality, originality and impact
