Resolution No. 152

The approval of the points of Resolution No. 225 of the BDI DIT falls within the jurisdiction of the following organizations:

- The BDI DIT decisions No. 225.1., 225.2., 225.3. regarding the termination of PhD students' legal status: under the authority of DIT, does not affect the MTTDHT<sup>1</sup>.
- Decision No. 225.4 of BDI DIT on the appointment of committee members for public PhD defenses: under the authority of MTTDHT<sup>2</sup>.

## 1 DOCTORAL AND HABILITATION REGULATIONS OF ÓBUDA UNIVERSITY

Budapest, 2025

(Version effective from April 29, 2025)

University Doctoral and Habilitation Council (EDHT)

6. §

(13) The EDHT

a) Maca appoints and relieves the members of the Doctoral School Council (hereinafter DIT) ;

*b) makes a decision regarding the removal from the student roster, a power which it delegates to the council of the doctoral school.;*

c) decides on applications for doctoral transfer either from other university doctoral schools or between doctoral schools within the university.

d) conducts habilitation procedures as defined in the regulations, delegating this authority to the MTTDHT or TÁMDHT;

e) appoints the official reviewers and the habilitation review committee, delegating this authority to the MTTDHT or TÁMDHT;

f) evaluates the report of the evaluation committee;

g) decides on the awarding of the title of habilitated doctor;

h) prepares the Senate's decisions related to habilitation;

i) It reviews appeals submitted against the decisions of the SZBB due to legal violations or breaches of regulations.

## 2 The process and procedural order of obtaining a doctoral degree

17. §

(5) The application for the authorization to obtain a degree must be submitted to the head of the doctoral school along with the attachments listed in Section 18 (1) points b), d), e), and f), as well as a maximum 2-page summary of the planned dissertation. The head of the doctoral school, based on the recommendation that also includes the DIT defense committee, forwards the application to the MTTDHT for technical and natural science training programs, and to the TÁMDHT for social and arts science training programs.

The procedure for reviewing a doctoral dissertation

22. §

(1) For the evaluation of a doctoral dissertation, in relation to technical and natural science training, the MTTDHT, and in relation to arts and social science training, the TÁMDHT appoints two official reviewers and a review committee on the recommendation of the relevant doctoral school council. One of the reviewers must not have an employment relationship with the University. Only one person may be the same between the workplace discussion and the public defense reviewers.

In its decision No. 152/1, ÓE MTTDHT approves the ÓE BDI DIT decision No. 225.4 regarding the initiation of the doctoral process of Aichaoui Nada El Yasmine (dissertation title: “Development of a Control System for Safe Collaborative Human-Robot Work in Welding Applications”, supervisor: Prof. Dr. Tünde Anna Kovács) with the following committee members:

23. §


(2) The review committee consists of at least 5 and at most 7 members, including a chairperson, two official reviewers, a secretary, and additional 1-3 members. The chairperson of the committee must be a university professor or Professor Emeritus of the University. When appointing the review committee, 3 alternate members must also be named, including individuals who can potentially substitute for the chairperson and secretary, and at least one possible alternate reviewer.

(3) Members and substitute members of the committee must hold an academic degree. At least one of the two official reviewers, as well as at least one of the other members of the review committee, must not be employed by the University. Among the official reviewers, at most one may be the same person as the preliminary opponent at the workplace. For students admitted after January 1, 2024, the official external reviewer must be a foreign citizen.
